

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All classes run in accordance with BE Rules
It is the responsibility of all competitors to ensure that their tack and dress are current in accordance with the Rules. An effective body protector must be worn for the Cross Country phase and is highly recommended for the Show Jumping phase
- Hats that conform to PAS015, ASTM 95, ASTM F1163, Snell E2001 AS/NZS3838 1998 or EN1384 standard and which displays the BSI Kite Mark, SEI or QAS must be worn with a chin strap, fastening at all times when mounted
A cover shall be worn for show jumping which is either dark blue or black
- Please note that earrings, studs or other body jewellery must not be worn
- Medical Armbands are compulsory for the Cross-Country phase
- The Judges' decision is final Any objections or complaints must be made in writing and handed to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the result being posted on the Scoreboard
- Entries will not accepted without the correct fee, the Organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry to, alter or cancel classes at their discretion
- No horse may compete under four years of age
- No horse may be ridden more than once on the day of the competition
- Refunds There will be no refund of the money after the closing date unless a Vet's or Doctor's Certificate is produced. In this event of a refund a £10.00 fee will be retained to cover administration costs. Replacements will be accepted.
- Elimination After three refusals at one fence the competitor will be eliminated. Depending on the ground conditions and individual circumstances the rider may continue to the next fence but must not in anyway impede other competitors. If refusals continue at following fences the Rider will be asked to leave the Course.
- Health and Safety The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure that Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take responsible precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, all Officials and Stewards. Additionally those attending this Event must report any accidents to the Secretary or Organiser of the Event. Property; Vehicle damage; Personal injury or Personal illness
- Cancellation The Organisers reserve the right to cancel should the weather or ground conditions are unsuitable. Please ring the Secretary if in doubt. In this event a £10.00 fee will be retained to cover administration costs
- Insurance Each competitor must carry their own insurance liability, whether Pony Club, Riding Club, BHS, BE or independent cover
- Litter & Horse Manure Please take away your litter and please do not clean out your boxes in the field, thank you.

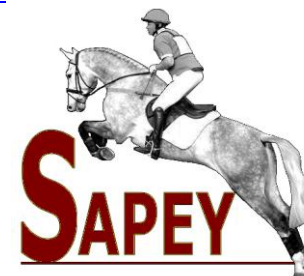

Show Jumping approx. 90cms
Cross Country up to 90cms
(equiv. to BE90)

Classes 3 & 4 Open only to Horse & Rider combinations who have not been placed 1st-3rd in any Sapey Horse Trials at Intro (BE90) or at higher levels of competition. HC accepted

CLASS 5 PRE-NOVICE OPEN

Dressage Test – BE Test 101 (2009)
Show Jumping approx. 100cms
Cross Country up to 100cms
(equiv. to BE 100)

Classes 5 Open only to Horse & Rider combinations who have not been placed 1st – 3rd in any Sapey Horse Trials at Pre-Novice (BE100) or at higher levels of competition. Any combination placed at Intro (BE90) accepted. HC accepted.

CLASS 6 NOVICE OPEN

Dressage Test – BE Test 114 (2009)
Show Jumping approx. approx. 110cms
Cross Country up to 110cms
(equiv. to BE Novice)

Classes 6 Open only to Horse & Rider combinations who have not been placed 1st – 3rd in any Sapey Horse Trials at Novice (BE Novice) or at higher levels of competition. Any combination placed at Pre-Novice, BE100 or below accepted. HC accepted.

Body Protectors and Medical Armbands: Compulsory for the Cross-Country phase and strongly recommended for Show Jumping

Hat Tagging: Hats must be tagged as inspected (PC, BE Rules). If not tagged you cannot compete. Please take your hats with you for inspection to the Secretary when you collect your Entry Number
