#### **RULES**

- 1. To be held under Pony Club Eventing Rules 2017. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure they are familiar with these rules. Copies of the rule book are available via the Pony Club website: <u>www.pcuk.org</u>.
- 2. Riders to provide their own number bibs and medical armbands. A limited number of bibs will be available £5 deposit in an envelope with the competitors name on please.
- 3. Hard hats which comply with the Pony Club rules must be worn and must be tagged. Body protectors complying with Pony Club rules must be worn for the cross-country phase and medical armbands are recommended– see rule book.
- 4. Organisers reserve the right to merge, cancel or alter any class depending on advance entries or weather conditions.
- 5. No horse/pony to be tied to any trailer/lorry and left unattended.
- 6. Excessive use of the whip, spurs or voice will result in elimination or ejection from the showground
- 7. Rudeness or failure to obey a direction given by a judge, steward or official will result in ejection from the showground
- 8. The judges' decision is final. Objections must be lodged with the secretary in writing with a non-refundable £10 deposit within 30 minutes of the end of the class.
- 9. Horses and ponies must be eligible for the class as detailed in the Pony Club Eventing rule book 2017.
- 10. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 11. All participants attend at their own risk.
- Open Classes 2, 4 6 & 8 Withdrawals up until the closing date 10<sup>th</sup> July will have their entries refunded. After the closing date entries will ONLY be refunded on receipt of a vets or doctors certificate. Area entries will be refunded in line with the Pony Club Rules 2017.

#### Legal Liability

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

3. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Radnor & West Hereford Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.

#### DIRECTIONS

From M5 South/Worcester/Leominster: Take A44. From Hereford A465 to Bromyard


Travelling north from Bromyard take the B4203 over Bromyard Downs. After 6 miles turn left at the crossroads for Wolferlow and Stoke Bliss.

From M5 North & Droitwich A443 / Stourport A451 to Gt Witley

From Gt Witley take the B4203 towards Bromyard for 6 miles, go through Upper Sapey and past Sapey Golf Club, 1 mile further turn right at the crossroads for Wolferlow and Stoke Bliss.

From A49 North / Ludlow Take the A456 to Tenbury Wells

From Tenbury Wells take B4204 towards Cliftonon-Teme. At the Upper Sapey Crossroads turn right B4203 towards Bromyard go through Upper Sapey and past Sapey Golf Club, 1 mile turn right at the crossroads for Wolferlow and Stoke Bliss.
