Withdrawals, Refunds & Cancellations:

- Full Refunds will be given up until the closing date of the competition.
- After the closing date no refunds will be made without a Doctors or Vets certificate produced no later than 24 hours after the event. If produced after this no refunds will be given.
- Refunds where due after the closing date are subject to an admin fee of £10
- In the event of abandonment 75% of the entry fee will be refunded.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

- To be run in accordance with Pony Club Eventing Rules 2022
- Please ensure competitors comply with, hat tagging, body protector and a responsible adult present
- **COMPETITORS TO PROVIDE THEIR OWN NUMBER BIB AND PRINT OFF THEIR OWN NUMBER A4 SIZE from www.horse-events.co.uk**
- Each competitor must carry their own insurance liability, whether Pony club, Riding club BHS BE or independent cover
- Late entries may be accepted at the organiser's discretion (please email natalie.fartown@outlook.com. Late Entry surcharge of £10.
- Queries may only be raised via the Secretary by the DC or their appointee. Protests/objections will be managed as per Rule 5.
- No horse will be allowed to compete in 2 classes.
- Photographic Rights: competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in PC events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the PC and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.
- A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials. **ALL HORSES MUST HAVE BEEN VACCINATED WITHIN THE LAST 6 MONTHS AND NOT LESS THAN 7 DAYS BEFORE 3 JULY.** Vaccinations must be in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2022.
- Competitors must also adhere to the current EHV (Equine Herpes Virus) rules and guidelines.
- Competitors may not school over the course within two weeks of the date of competition.
- In the event of high levels of entries for the PC classes, there may be a ballot for UA entries.

THERE WILL BE A TACK CHECK IN PLACE PRIOR TO EACH DISCIPLINE IN ACCORDANCE WITH PC RULES FOR ALL COMPETITORS

AWARDS

- Individual Rosettes from 1st to 10th place in each section.
- Team Rosettes from 1st to 6th place in each section.
- Rosette for Best Dressage in each section
