Eventer Challenge Course – jump a course of 7-10 show jumping obstacles, followed immediately by 15-20 cross-country jumping efforts.

B. B.R.C. Junior Challenge 90 Area Qualifier (Teams & Individuals)

C. Open Novice Eventer Challenge (Individuals only)

Maximum height of Show jumping and Cross-country: 90cm

CLASS 3: Eventer Challenge 100cm

B. B.R.C. Junior Challenge 100 Area Qualifier (Teams & Individuals)

C. Open Intermediate Eventer Challenge (Individuals only)

Maximum height of Show jumping & Cross-country: 100cm

ENTRY FEES: (include Medical Cover contribution)

Individuals: £45 per combination per class.

£40 for Bewdley Bridle Club members

Teams (BRC Area Qualifiers only): £180 per team

£160 for Bewdley Bridle Club members

All Classes, rosettes 1st to 6th place. Open classes will have senior and junior sections but may be combined if insufficient numbers.

Paper numbers will be provided. Please bring your own bib.

Entries will be limited and a waiting list held if necessary. In Classes One, Two and Three priority will be given to those entering the B.R.C. Area Qualifiers.

LATE ENTRIES -please contact the Entries Secretary for any available spaces. Late Entry fee of £10 to be added to any Entry Fees.

Withdrawals: to be made before 26th Sept; after that date, refunds only given on production of a vet/medical certificate sent to the Entries Secretary with an s.a.e.

Any refund may be subject to an administration fee of £5 per combination per class.

Each team will have to provide two helpers (all day) for one team, three helpers for two teams, four helpers for three or more teams. Names and email addresses for the helpers MUST be provided on the entry form. Failure to do so will mean teams not being allowed to compete.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY/RULES and REGULATIONS

Health, Safety and Welfare. "The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards"

Legal Liability: "Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom in law they are responsible, neither the organisers for the event to which these rules apply nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representatives of these bodies, accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars or their contents and accessories, or any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever."

- 1. Emergencies: emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times and members of the public must not park vehicles so as to obstruct access. First Aid points are clearly marked. In case of an emergency, members of the public should contact the nearest official or dial 999 on the nearest telephone.
- 2. Horses can be easily frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from horse areas/lanes and to avoid any behaviour which might alarm horses.
- 3. Dogs must be kept under close control and on a lead at ALL times. Please clean up behind your dog and take your bags home. Bins are NOT provided.
- 4. INSURANCE: please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.
- 5. Hard hats to the standards in BRC 2018 rulebook must be worn at all times while mounted. BRC competitors must have an aqua coloured tag. Body protectors to BETA 3 (purple label) 2009 or later and medical armbands (worn on the arm) are compulsory.
- 6. STOP WATCHES, HEAD CAMS or other recording devices are NOT allowed.
- 7. The Judges' decision and that of the Official Stewards (BRC Area Qualifiers) is final.
- 8. The Organisers reserve the right to alter or amend the schedule, if necessary.
- 9. Any objections or protests must be handed into the Show Secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the incident together with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld).

Objections regarding Area Qualifiers classes need to be made in accordance with BRC rules to the identified Official Steward(s).

- 10.All classes run under B.R.C. Rules 2018 it is the Competitors' responsibility to ensure that they are familiar with these rules as regards tack, turnout, eligibility (for Qualifier classes) and how the competition is run.
- 11.XC colours to be worn. Correct riding attire must be worn at all times when mounted and for the dismounted prize-giving. A vet will be available all day. A farrier may be on-call. It is the responsibility of the individual whose horse is being treated to settle all fees.
- 12. Competitors in difficulty should give way to overtaking horses.
- 13. Competitors eliminated on the cross-country course must leave the course at a walk and must not jump any fences after retiring/elimination. Competitors must adhere to instructions given by the fence judge.

The Committee reserves the right to ask anybody to leave the show ground, with no compensation, for any abuse (verbal or physical) of horses/ponies, other riders, officials or members of the public
