### **Schedule**

**Class 1 Hunter Trial Pairs** (9am)

**Entry Fee:** £45 prior to closing date £55 thereafter per pair (includes medical levy).

**Prizes:** Prizes in kind 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> Rosettes to 4th place

Special Rules: Pairs to ride to an undisclosed optimum time (fair hunting pace). Closest to

optimum time wins, time of second rider to count.

Course: Approx 1.25 miles. Height approx 80-85cm with some hedges.

Horses/Ponies: To be over 13.2hh and 4 years or over.

Class 2 Hunter Trial Individual (approx. 10.30am)

**Entry Fee:** £26 prior to closing date £30 thereafter (includes medical levy).

**Prizes:** Prizes in kind 1st to 4th Rosettes to 4th place

Special Rules: Individuals to ride to an undisclosed optimum time (fair hunting pace). Closest

to optimum time wins

Course: Approx 1.25 miles. Height approx 80-85cm with some hedges.

Horses/Ponies: To be over 13.2hh and 4 years or over.

Class 3 INTERMEDIATE TEAM CHASE – (SPEED) (approx. 12 noon)

Entry fee: £125

Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup>-£170, 2<sup>nd</sup> £100, 3<sup>rd</sup> £70 Rosettes to 6th place

**Special Rules:** Teams to consist of three or four members. Fastest three to count

Course: Approx 1.5 miles. with a pen (se rule 24 for penalties) No fixed Element will

exceed 115cm with some larger hedges.

Horses/Ponies: To be over 14.2hh and 5 years or over. Riders – 16 years and older



Class 4 Novice Team Chase

**Entry fee**: £110 (includes MFHA and medical levy).

**Prizes:** 1<sup>st</sup>- £120, 2<sup>nd</sup> £90, 3<sup>rd</sup> £50 Rosettes to 6th place

Special Rules: Teams to consist of three or four members to ride to an undisclosed optimum

time (fair hunting pace). Closest to optimum time wins

Course: Approx 1.45 miles. with a pen (se rule 24 for penalties) No fixed Element will

exceed 100cm with some larger hedges.

Horses/Ponies: To be over 14.2hh and 5 years or over.

**Class 5** Hunters Challenge

**Entry Fee:** £30 prior to closing date £36 thereafter (includes medical levy).

**Prizes:** Prizes in kind 1st to 4th Rosettes to 4th place

Special Rules: Individuals to ride a continual round of Show Jumps and XC Fences starting with

Fence 1-7 (show jumps), then proceeding out on to fences 8-16 (Cross Country) TBC ending in the Arena for the final 4 show jumping fences. The combination closest to

the Optimum Time without penalties will win.

Course: Height approx 80-85cm with some hedges.

Horses/Ponies: To be over 13.2hh and 4 years or over.

# **Rules & Regulations**

**INSURANCE.** It is a requirement that all participants carry Third Party Insurance for not less than £5m. It is strongly recommended that all participants also have Personal Accident Insurance.

**ACCEPTANCE OF RULES.** This Event is run under the auspices of the MFHA as the Governing Body and will be run in accordance with their Rules which are on the Team Chasing website (www.teamchasing.co.uk) and will be displayed on the day. If you require a copy of the MFHA Team Chasing Rules, please send an SAE to the Entries' Secretary. All competitors at this Event are bound by these Rules together with the following regulations:

1. All competitors (or designated adult if under 17 years) will be required to sign a disclaimer on collection of their bibs at the Secretary's Tent.



- 2. All hats must be tagged –see new rules. Tags will be available at the Secretary's Tent at a charge of £2 per hat.
- 3. All competitors must wear a BETA approved and appropriately labelled Level 3 body protector manufactured in or after 2000. Random inspections will be carried out and any competitor in breach of this regulation will not be allowed to compete.
- 4. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel any class or event, to transfer competitors between classes, to refuse an entry, to alter advertised times, to withhold all or any prize money, and to eliminate any competitor to be adjudged not to be adhering to the Rules.

#### 5. RULES

PLEASE NOTE NEW SAFETY REGULATIONS WITH HATS AND BODY PROTECTORS Hats will be identified by a BTC, BE, BRC, or Pony Club approved Hat Tag. I.e. Hats must meet one of the following standards: British All PAS015 1998/2011 with kitemark; VG1 with kitemark; All ASTM F1163: 2004 onwards with SEI mark; SNELL E2001 or E2016 with Snell label and number, or Australian and New Zealand All AS/NZS 3838 2006-onwards hats.

All competitors must also wear a British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA 2009) approved and appropriately labelled Level 3 (purple label) body protector, manufactured in the year 2009 or after. A body protector of this nature is also required when competitors are wearing air jackets of any make. For full details see British Team Chasing rules http://www.teamchasing.co.uk/rulebook.
