- Hats must be worn that conform to PAS015 (1998 or 2011); VG01.040 2014-12; ASTM F1163: 2004a, Snell 2001 or 2016 AS/NZS 3838 2006 and which displays EITHER the BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC Mark or SEI, fastened correctly at all times when mounted. Cross Country Protective Headwear' is a "Jockey Skull" of an even round or elliptical shape with a smooth or slightly abrasive surface, having no peak or peak type extensions. A removable hat cover with a light flexible peak may be used. Protective headwear for the Show Jumping phase to be either dark blue or black
- An effective body protector must be worn for the Cross Country phase and is highly recommended for the Show Jumping phase
- Please note that earrings, studs or other body jewellery must not be worn
- Medical Bands it is the responsibility of the Rider to wear a Medical Card if they have a medical condition that may impact on their care in the case of an emergency
- The Judges' decision is final Any objections or complaints must be made in writing and handed to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the result being posted on the Scoreboard. A fee of £20 is payable which is only refundable if the objection or complaint is upheld
- <u>Entries</u> will not accepted without the correct fee, the Organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry to, alter, merge or cancel classes at their discretion
- <u>Competitor's Age</u> No competitor can compete unless they are in the year of their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday at 80cms or above heights. To compete at 70cm a competitor must be in their 10<sup>th</sup> year with the support of a Pony Club DC, or a recognised BHS or BE Trainer. Under 10yrs at the discretion of the organiser with support of a Pony Club DC or a BHS or BE Trainer
- No horse may compete under four years of age
- No horse may be ridden more than once on the day of the competition
- <u>Refunds</u> There will be No Refund of entry money after the Closing Date without a Vet's or Doctor's
   Certificate, please contact the Secretary for details. In the event of a refund a £15 fee will be retained to
   cover administration costs. Substitutions will be accepted.
- <u>Elimination</u> After three refusals at any one fence or four cumulative refusals the competitor will be eliminated, and must leave the course at a walk.
- Outside Assistance It is forbidden to give any outside assistance to help a competitor during any phase of the event
- Rider Fall or Horse Fall will be an elimination in any phase of the event. Riders who have a fall must be check over by the Doctor before leaving the site. Likewise a Vet must check over a horse who has fallen
